***Upcoming work to replace the existing Carolina Piedmont railroad crossing on Woodruff Road***

GREENVILLE, S.C. – Work on the 85-385 Gateway Project continues and coming up shortly will be the replacement of an existing railroad crossing along Woodruff Road.

The railroad crossing is located just east of the Woodruff and Garlington roads intersection and nearly in front of the Fuddruckers. This work will facilitate the future upgrades to Woodruff Road planned for 2018 and 2019.

Weather permitting, the first phase of this replacement work will begin around 7 a.m. on Saturday, April 1 and is expected to be completed by 7 p.m. The second phase will begin around 7 a.m. on Sunday, April 2 and extend through 7 p.m. During both phases of work, Woodruff Road will be limited to one lane in each direction. Additionally, at some point on Saturday, a complete 15-minute cessation of traffic will be required to install the new railroad track.

Drivers are being asked to avoid this area this weekend, if at all possible. Additionally, drivers are asked to remain patient and obey all traffic control devices and signs while traversing construction zones.
